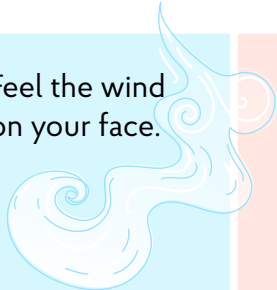
Smell
