The Makery Services Policy

Purpose

The purpose of the Makery Services Policy is to set guidelines to protect the equipment and property of the Westmont Public Library.

General guidelines

In order to assure the integrity of the Makery equipment, patrons will be required to fill out an appropriate user agreement and may be required to undergo a training orientation in order to be granted access. Patrons in or below 5th grade must have consent or supervision from a parent/legal guardian to use Makery services and collections.

When not offered through a program, the Makery equipment is only available for in-house use, with reservation priority given to Westmont residents. Staff and patrons are required to take all applicable safety precautions in connection with use of the space and equipment. Any loss or damage to equipment is the responsibility of the patron as outlined in the user agreement. A limit on the number of participants that may use a Makery tool at one time may be imposed. Some equipment within the Makery collection may have associated fees; please see the Schedule of Fines and Fees for further details.
